Beholding is an invitation to that life. Not only praying to God or working for God but living in and with God in our everyday ordinary moments, enchanting our entire lives. Discover the beauty, wonder, and stillness of a life of friendship and unceasing prayer with God and see how learning to behold and be beheld by God may just spark the transformational movement for which these times are crying.

We will read about 50 pages a week, taking notes, marking up the margins! When we gather in our contemplative setting with some music and quiet listening, we will share what we are learning, what God is showing us, what makes sense and what doesn't.
